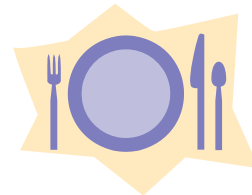
ROOMING:

- Two bedroom suites with shared bathrooms or two-person rooms in lodges with community bathrooms.
- Linens and extra blankets are provided.
- Dispenser soap (individuals may want to bring their own soap).
- You may want to bring a fan during the summer.
- **Check out time** for the Straits Lodge is **9 am**, all other Lodges is **10 am**.
- **Smoking is not allowed inside any of the buildings.**
- **Check in time is 3:00 pm.**



DINING:

- **We place the food on the tables precisely at the scheduled times.**
- Coffee is provided in the main lounge at 6:30 a.m. for early risers.
- Family style. Extra servings on all items are provided. Just bring empty platters to the kitchen.
- Let your meeting planner know of any special menu requests (vegetarian, low salt, etc.).
- Hot water, low fat or skim milk, catsup may be obtained from the kitchen. Just ask the cooks!



RECREATION:

- Swimming in Higgins Lake. Canoes and a rowboat are also provided.
- Pool table in the lower level of the main classroom building.
- Volleyball in the lake and in recreation field across the road.
- Horseshoe pits are located on the west side of the Administration Building.
- There is a large fireplace lounge in the Administration Building which is a nice area for card playing and sing-a-longs.
- Hiking and cross-country ski trails are located adjacent to the Conference Center property.
- There are several public golf courses within a 15-mile radius of the Conference Center.
- Movie theaters can be found in surrounding communities. Check our bulletin board for what is showing.
- Many of the groups enjoy a bonfire on the beach.

MISCELLANEOUS:

- Pets are not allowed at the conference center. Call us for information on local kennels.
- Two convenience stores in the immediate area are open until 8:00 p.m.
- House phones are located in the Administration Building, Classroom Building and all of our lodges. They can be used for "1-800" calls and operator assisted calls (1+0+).
