

Circuit Coordinator

The role of *The Future is Now* Circuit Coordinator is to lead his congregation to take part in *The Future is Now* by making a formal commitment to participate, and then encourage three to four other congregations to do the same.

Circuit Coordinator Responsibilities:

- Pray for the success of *The Future is Now*;
- Promote *The Future is Now* in his own congregation and encourage the congregation to be among the first to commit to *The Future is Now*;
- Advocate for other congregations in the circuit to participate in *The Future is Now* by formally committing to be involved by adopting a fundraising target (or goal);
- Invite and secure attendance of pastors and their lay leaders to attend an orientation workshop;
- Connect congregational leaders with material on conducting effective *The Future is Now* appeals;
- Lead discussions and answer questions on *The Future is Now* at circuit conferences/meetings; and
- Attend congregation meetings when possible (such as elders, council and/or voters' assemblies).

Time Requirements:

- Circuit Coordinators are encouraged to serve one or two hours weekly to facilitate the aforementioned areas throughout his circuit during the planning and active campaign timetable (about four to six months).
